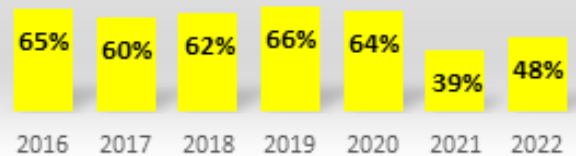
Editor's Brief

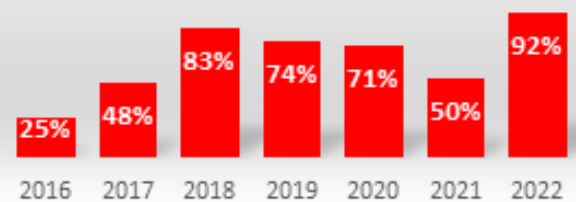

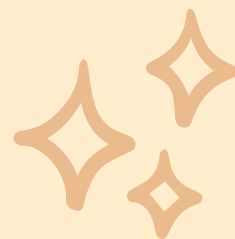

Teachers' at AOGHS prepared themselves extensively to welcome their students' for yet another academic year.



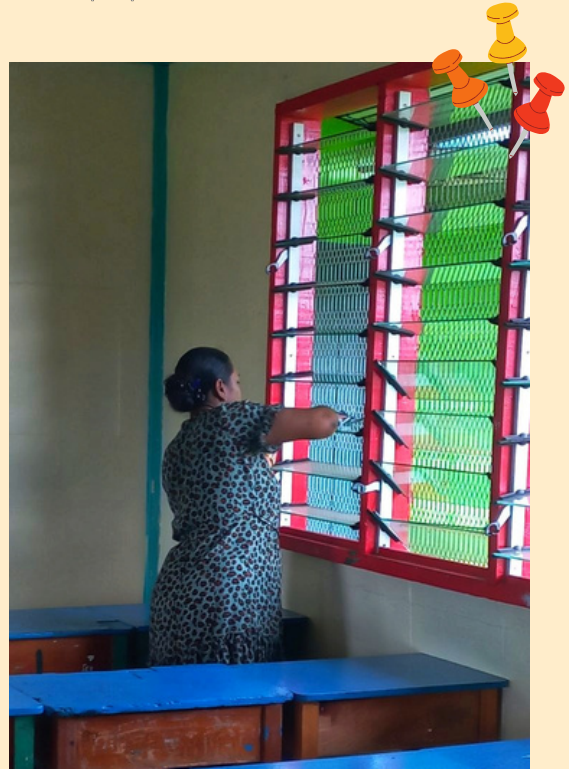
The five days of Professional Development sessions covered various topics to help teachers' grow their skills in all aspects of teaching.
