SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

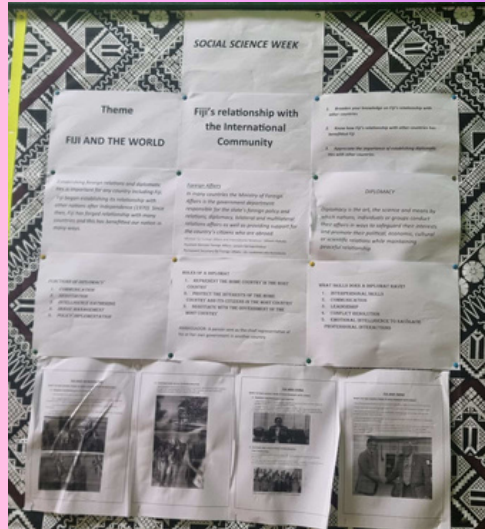

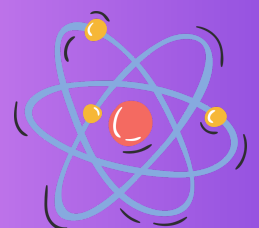
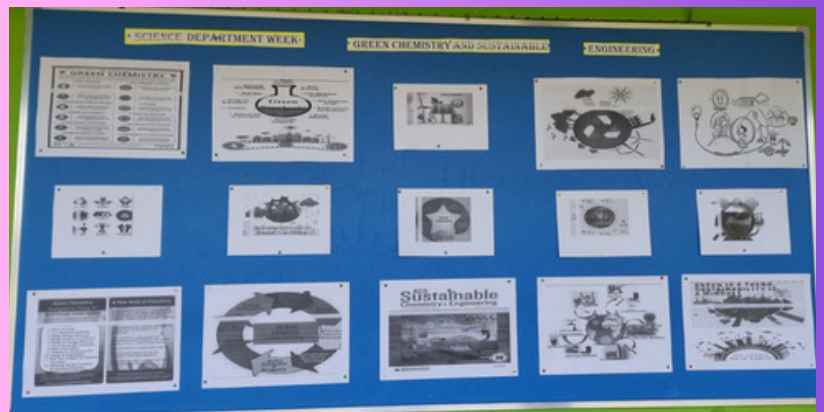
SOCIAL SCIENCE

Department teachers with students displayed charts and organized activities where students got chance to participate and win prizes.



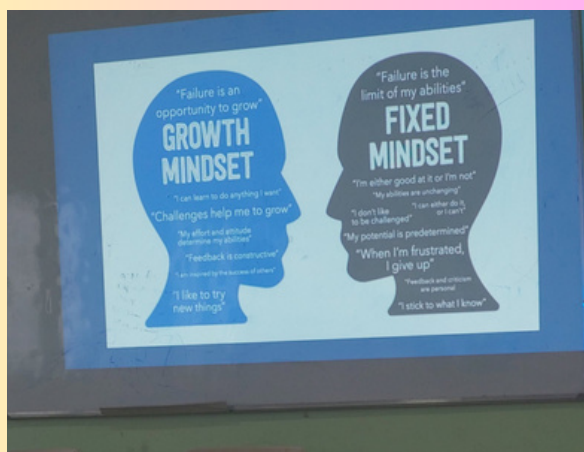
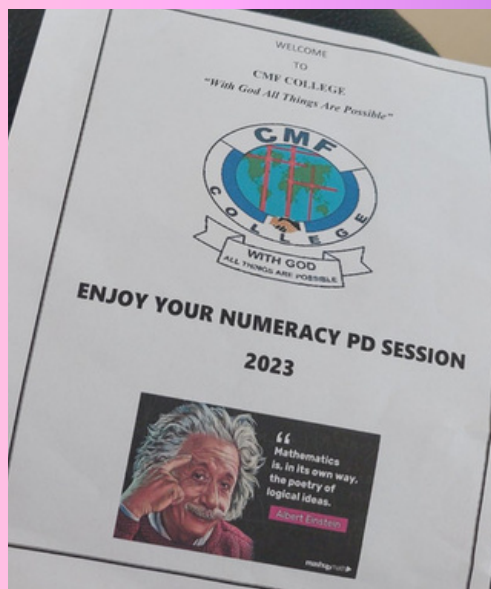
SCIENCE WEEK

"I feel happy when its Friday as I get to eat varieties of fruits on this day. They provide a wide range of nutrients such as vitamin C," says Vanshika of 9D.



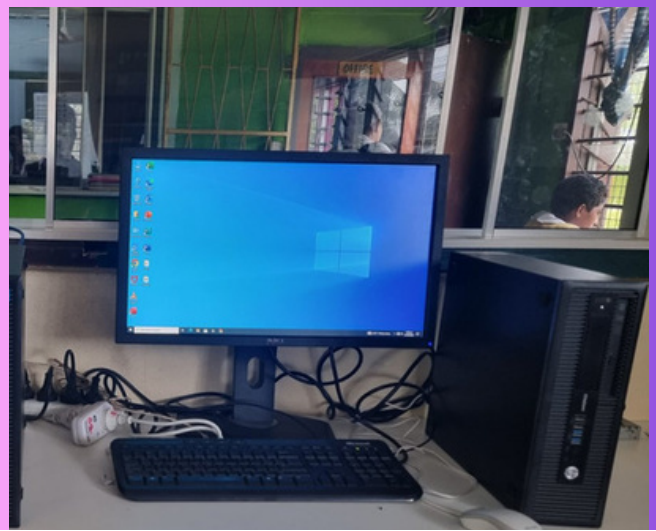
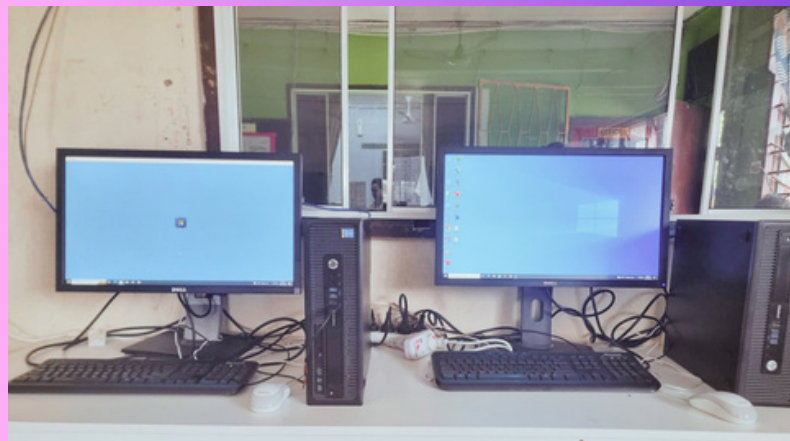
Renovation
