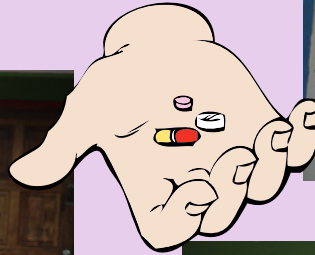




# DRUG AWARENESS WEEK

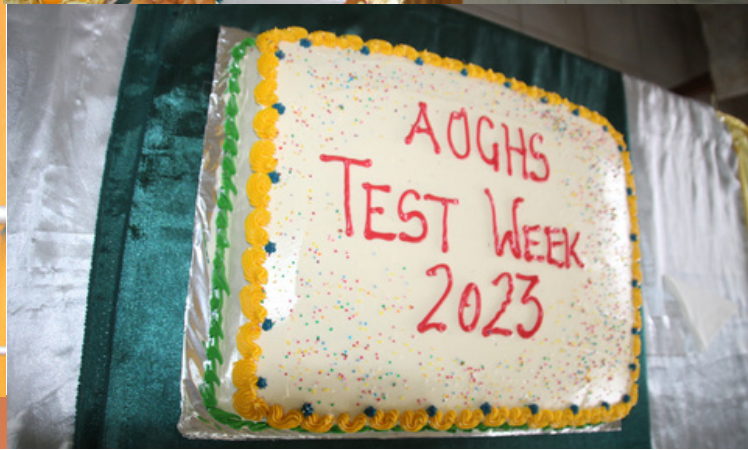


# TEST WEEK

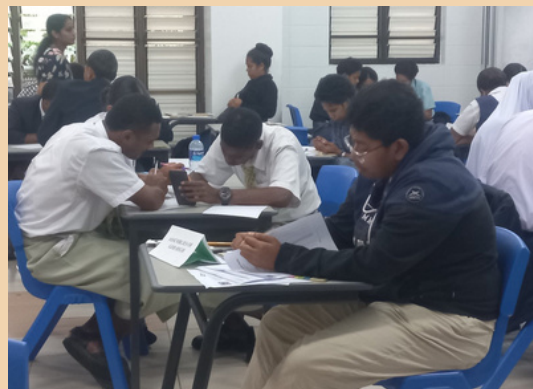

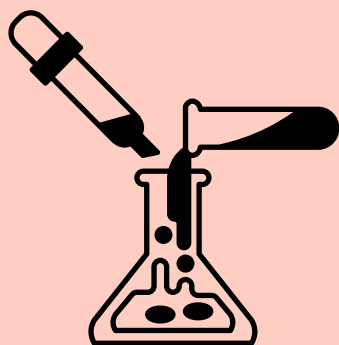
Finals will be held at USP on September 23rd. The participants will compete with other 25 secondary schools from Central and Western Divisions.
