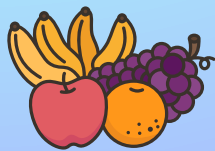
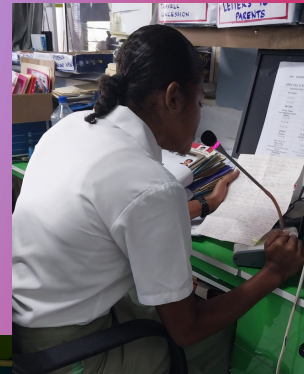


# DEPARTMENT WEEKS

# WORLD BOOK DAY



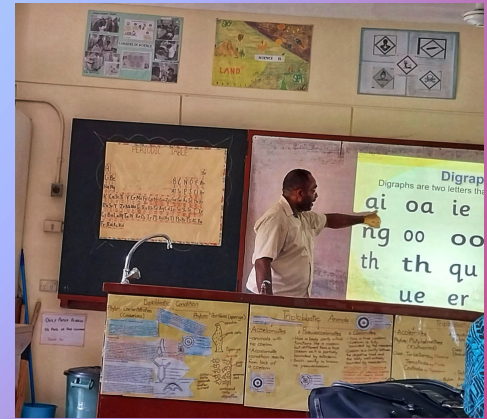
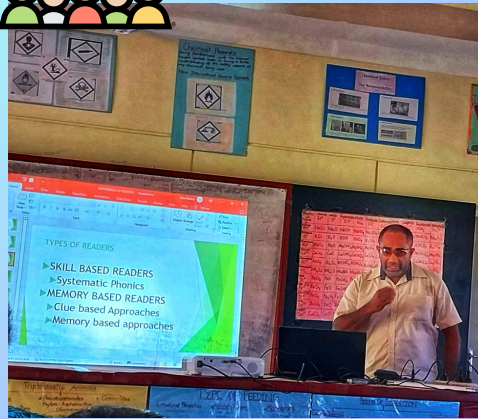
*The celebration was held in school on the 26th of this month by the Language department. During this program students from various forms prepare speech, drama, poems and character parade.*
